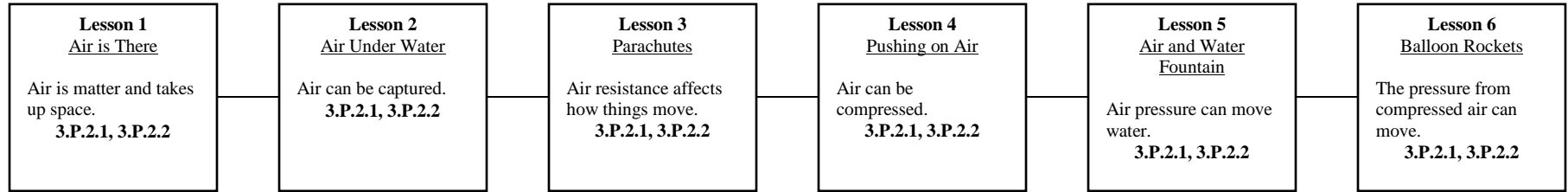


Second Grade *Air and Weather Concept Storyline*

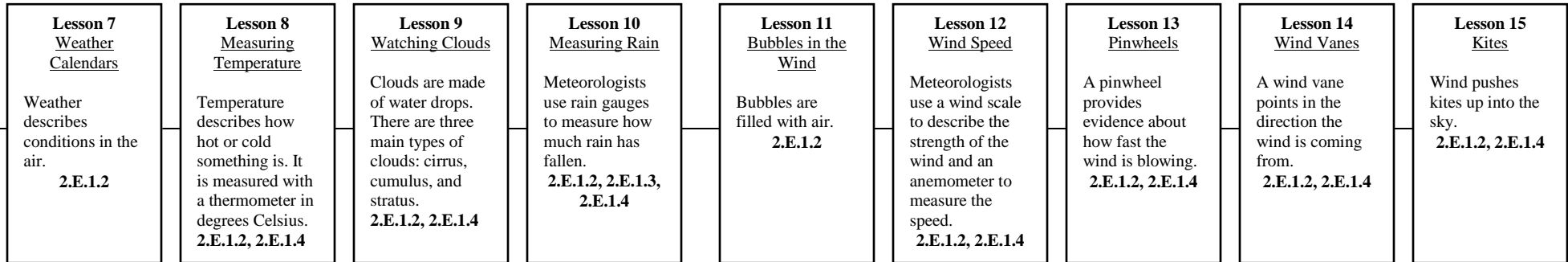
Unifying Concept: Basic tools are used to gather observations and information about weather. Air is matter; has properties; and relates to weather.

Sub-concept: Earth materials include air (gases of the atmosphere). Air has specific properties that can be measured using tools.



Sub-concept: Weather changes from day to day and over seasons. Weather can be described by measurable quantities such as temperature, wind direction and precipitation.

Sub-concept: Wind is moving air.



Sub-concept: Objects in the sky have patterns of movement. The sun provides the light and heat necessary to maintain the temperature of the Earth.
