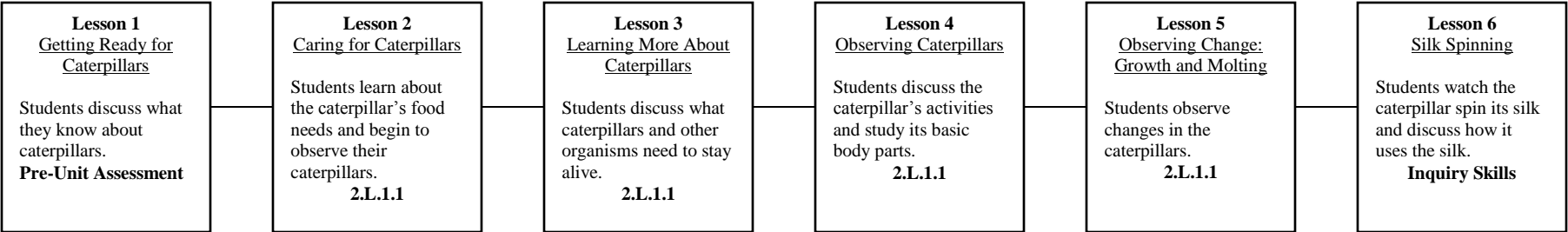

The Life Cycle of Butterflies Concept Storyline

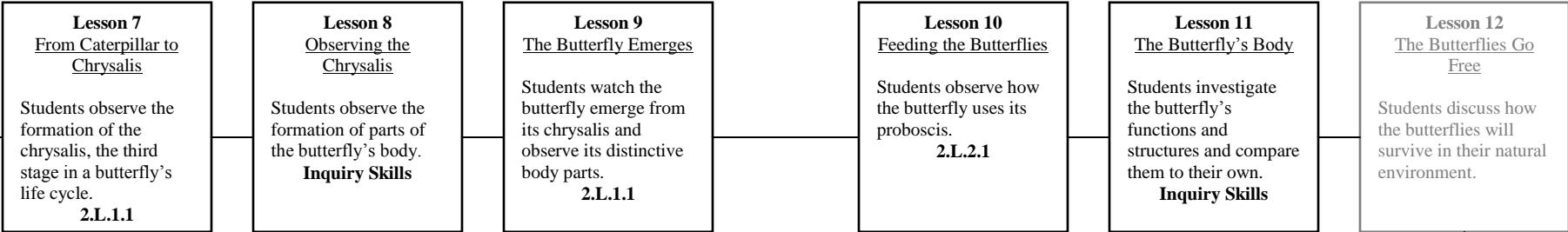
Unifying Concept: Organisms change forms and behaviors as part of their life cycles; survive only in specific habitats; are equipped with the mechanisms to survive; and can be classified using data.

Sub-concept: Caterpillars represent one stage of a butterfly's life cycle.



Sub-concept: As part of its life cycle, the butterfly forms and emerges from a chrysalis.

Sub-concept: The structures of a butterfly provide the means for its essential life functions.



Sub-concept: Scientists use data on organisms' structures and life cycles to understand and classify living things.
